Date of Decision-14.03.2018: Disposed of with directions.

ORDER

FACTS:

1. The appellant sought copies of the DPC proposal sent to DST for placement of Superintending Surveyors, certified copies of its approved proposal by the DPC etc. through 4 points. The CPIO on 29.07.2016 intimated that the desired information runs into 252 pages and accordingly sought a sum of Rs. 504/-. The appellant filed first appeal on the ground that the information provided was vague, incorrect and incomplete. The FAA stated that the information provided is in accordance with sequence as found in the concerned file and also informed that the assessment sheet has not been provided to the appellant under the pretext of personal information. Being dissatisfied, the appellant approached this Commission.

Decision :

2. The appellant stated that he retired as Superintendent from Survey of India and he wants the information sought to challenge in the competent Court of Law. The officer submitted that the information as sought was provided to the appellant and there is nothing to be given since the entire copies of the concerned file has been provided to him except assessment sheets.

3. The Commission directs the respondent authority to facilitate inspection of documents and provide certified copies of selected documents along with the

copies of assessment sheets, within 5 days from the date of receipt of this Order. Disposed of.
