**Relevant facts emerging from the Appeal:**

**Information sought:**

The Appellant sought to know whether any study has been ordered at the level of IHQ of MoD(Army) to research the subject matter of unhealthy inflationary trends observed in CRs rendered on officers of the IA and make recommendations towards arresting and reversal of this trend and statistical information on the certain aspects pertaining to CRs rendered on officers of 1989 batch of 4 arms/services i.e Armoured Corps, Army Air Defence, Engineering and Army Services Corps.

**Grounds for the Second Appeal:**

The CPIO has not provided the desired information on para 4(c) of the RTI Application.

**Relevant Facts emerging during Hearing:**

The following were present:-

**Appellant:** Not present.

**Respondent:** Lt Col R.N. Sharma, CPIO, Col R.S. Chandel, Col MS(Legal), Col Sunil Jaggi, IHQ of MoD(Army) and Lt Col Harpreet Singh, JD MS, O/o DGMS(Army) present in person.

CPIO submitted that information sought vide para 4(c) is of such nature which would require collection and collation of voluminous data and the same was intimated to the Appellant vide their revised reply dated 05.12.2016.

**Decision**

Appellant has not availed the opportunity to appear before the Commission to plead his case or contest CPIO's submissions.

Commission does not find any infirmity in the CPIO reply based on the perusal of facts on record. Accordingly, Commission upholds the submission of the CPIO. No further action is warranted.

**The appeal is dismissed.**
