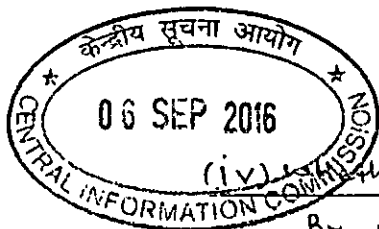

1) Feeling aggrieved by non-supply of information sought, the Appellant has preferred this appeal under Rule 15 of the Bombay High Court Right to Information (Revised) Rules, 2009.

2) The particulars of the information sought by the Appellant are as follows :-

- (i) The applicant had made an application to Hon'ble Bombay High Court dated 02.07.2007 through the Superintendent, Arthur Road Jail (Mumbai Central Prison), Mumbai vide O.W. No. 22525/2007 dated 7.7.2007. Kindly furnish the following details of the same:
 - a) Date of receipt of application.
 - b) Name and designation of the person who received the application.
 - c) Registration no. of the application.
 - d) Details of action taken on the application.
 - e) Certified order copy of this application.
- (ii) The applicant had made a reminder application to Hon'ble Registrar, Bombay High Court dated 01.02.2010, which was forwarded by the Supdt Arthur Road Jail, Mumbai vide O.W. No. 521/2010 dated 4.2.2010, kindly furnish all the details about this application which are sought in question (i).

3) Since the Appellant is an under trial prisoner, he has expressed his inability to attend the hearing unless a production warrant is issued. The Appellant has by his application dated 2nd August, 2011 furnished his written arguments at Exhibit-A. Perused the written arguments.

4) It appears from the written arguments that the Appellant is in judicial custody since fast 4 ½ years with no source of income. The information sought by him ought to have been given to him by the Public Information Officer as regards his application dated 2.7.2007 vide O.W No. 22525/07. Further he appears to have sent a reminder dated 1.2.2010 vide O.W. No. 521/10 dated 4.2.2010 seeking information. There is no reason why the information should be denied to the Appellant as sought for by him vide his aforesaid application dated 30.9.2010. The Public Information Officer is directed to furnish the information sought for by the Appellant within 8 days of receipt of this order.

5) Since the applicant is an under trial prisoner he can be considered as a person below poverty line and the information be provided to him free of cost, as also the information has not been provided within the time limit specified in sub-section (6) of Section 7 of the Right to Information Act, the Appeal is allowed.

6) The Appellant shall be informed accordingly.
