


The appellant was present when Shri Y.K. Singhal, JS cum CPIO, RTI Cell and Shri S.P. Beck, JS(Admin) cum CPIO were also present during the hearing.

Decision with reasons:-

- 2. During the hearing, the appellant wanted to know the unrealized amount of penalty and the total number of such cases. It was informed to him that there are 281 penalty cases amounting to Rs.40 lacs are to be recovered by the Commission. The appellant has requested to provide a list of these 281 cases. The JS(Law) has informed that the list of 281 cases has been provided to the appellant. However, the appellant has sought the similar information for a certain period on Point(A) (i) to (v). In this regard, Shri Singhal has submitted that a complete data base of penalty imposed and recovered by the Commission has been prepared, therefore, we may provide the same to the appellant and appellant can extract the information from it. Direction is accordingly given to Shri Y.K. Singhal, JS(Law) to provide the complete data base to the appellant within 1 week from the date of receipt of the order.
- 3. On Points (B), (C) & (F) of the RTI application, direction is given to Shri S.P. Beck, JS(Admin) cum CPIO to provide the information to the appellant within 2 weeks from the date of receipt of the order and also offer inspection as sought in Point (D) to the appellant with mutual consent.
- 4. On Point (E) of the RTI application, direction is given to Shri Sushil Kumar, DS(Admin) cum CPIO to offer the inspection of the concerned file to the appellant with mutual consent.

The appeal is, therefore, disposed of accordingly.





6. In case the appellant is aggrieved by the decision, he is free to file second appeal, if he so desires, before the CIC in Room No.185, Ground Floor, August Kranti Bhawan, Bhikaji Cama Place, New Delhi-110066 against this order within 90 days.
