



## Decision with reasons:-

- 1. In the RTI application dated 28.03.2016 addressed to Smt. Manjula Prasher, the applicant has sought certain information, which is not understood. The said RTI application has been diarized as Dy.No.127908/2016. However, in the first appeal the appellant has mentioned Diary No.155636/2015, therefore, it seems that in the RTI application, the applicant wants to know the action taken on the said diary number.
