Brief facts of the case:-

- (ii) a copy of the NOTE FILE orders of the competent authority (from beginning to latest orders obtained)."
- 2. In the appeal, the appellant has stated that as on 05.06.2017 a period of 70 days have been elapsed but he did not get any reply from the concerned CPIO of CIC and requested to take action against the CPIO under Section 20(2).

As regards delay in providing information, it has been informed by CPIO, RTI Cell that he has received the said RTI application diarised vide Dy No.112648 dated 23.02.2017 from Central Registry-II on 29.05.2017 and accordingly registered the same on 30.05.2017 and it was informed to him by DR to CR-II that the said RTI application inadvertently mixed up with other daks.
 - It is further to be mentioned that FAA, CIC has no authority to impose penalty 5. under section 20(2) of the RTI Act.
 - The appeal is disposed off. 6.
 - In case the appellant is aggrieved by the decision, he is free to file second appeal, if he so desires, before the CIC in Room No.185, Ground Floor, August Kranti Bhawan, Bhikaji Cama Place, New Delhi-110066 against this order within 90 days.
