Brief facts of the case:-

In the RTI application, the appellant has enclosed a copy of his representation dated 08.09.2017 and stated as under:-

"The above representation is self-explanatory on the violation of Sec.2(h), 7(1) and 20(1) of the RTIA by the Srimi Food Park Pvt. Ltd.

I shall be thankful to be enlightened on the authority for not taking action against the Srimi Food Park for violation of the RTI even after 948 days."

2. Shri T.K. Mohapatra, DR to CR-II vide letter dated 26.12.2017 has responded as under:

"Your letter dated 8.9.2017 diarized vide dy.no.166252 has already been linked electronically in the e.book of the case file no.CIC/KY/A/2016/001134 to take necessary action by the Dy Registrar of the concerned registry."

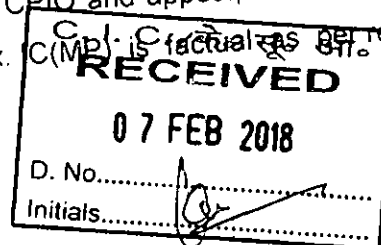
He endorsed a copy of his letter dated 26.12.2017 to the CPIO/Registrar IC(MP) for providing further information directly to the applicant.

3. In response to Shri Mohapatra letter dated 26.12.2017, Shri R.L. Gupta, CPIO cum DO to ex.IC(MP) vide letter dated 05.01.2018 has provided following information:-

"Your Communication dated 08.09.2017 Diary No.166252 was forwarded to the CPIO on 20.10.2017 to send a report regarding full and final compliance of the Commission order and has also been reminded. Copy enclosed."


