**Brief facts of the face:-**

In the RTI application, the appellant has sought 12 points information in respect of traffic intersection in front of the office building of the Central Information Commission.

In the appeal, the appellant has stated that no response received from the CPIO within the specified time limit.

**Decision with reasons:-**

2. On perusal of the case file, it is observed that the information on Points 4(a), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g) & (i) has been furnished by Shri S.K. Rabbani, DS(GA) cum CPIO vide letter No.14/1/2017/CIC/Admin/RTI dated 23.03.2018 (**copy enclosed**). It is further observed that the point-wise reply on the above mentioned points furnished by the CPIO is found appropriate. Rest of the points of the RTI application have been transferred to DCP, Traffic(HQ), Delhi u/s 6(3) by the CPIO, therefore, the appellant is advised to approach concerned public authority, if required.

3. The appeal is, therefore, disposed off accordingly.

4. In case the appellant is aggrieved by the decision, he is free to file second appeal, if he so desires, before the Central Information Commission, Baba Gang Nath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 against this order within 90 days.

above address within thirty days of the receipt of this letter.

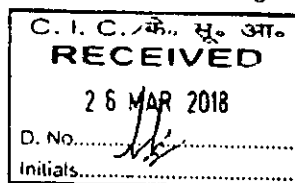

1. Vide DCP (Traffic) HQ Dev Prakash Shastri Marg, New Delhi letter no. 6583-6584/TE (D-II)/Traffic dated 27.09.2016 (copy enclosed), permission was granted for turning and entry of vehicles into CIC New Building by cutting the Central Partition of the road at Baba Gang Nath Marg.
2. Based on above permission, way for turning and entry of vehicles into CIC New Building has been made by cutting the Central Partition of the road at Baba Gang Nath Marg. However problem is being faced in entering the vehicles in Commission New Building due to non availability of traffic signal light for controlling the traffic.
3. In view of above, it is requested that new traffic signal may kindly be installed in front of Central Information Commission New Building after proper survey of the traffic at Baba Gang Nath Marg opposite the Commission New Building.
4. An early action is requested as the Commission New Building will be inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister during the end of the month.
