The appellant was present. Shri K.L. Das, CPIO & DO to IC(BJ) and Shri Ashok Kumar Sharma, CPIO, RTI Cell were present.

Brief facts of the case:-

As per appeal, the appellant was aggrieved with the information provided by the CPIO on points 5 & 6 of the RTI application. On Points 5 & 6, appellant has sought following information:-

- "5. Number of Show-Cause Notice issued proceedings pending from Honble IC(BJ) as on current date along with Expected date by which the same will be completed.
- Provide the proof for Sno 5 that the same are listed on Website under MIS Reports, If not then, provide the list and expected date by which the same will be uploaded."
- 2. Shri K.L. Das, CPIO & DO to IC(BJ) vide letter dated 21.06.2018 has furnished following information:-

"Point No.5:- 155 (As on 1.06.2018) (Efforts are being made to dispose them). It is however, not possible to indicate any specific date for their disposal.

Point No.6:- The Show-Cause Notices are contained in the orders of the respective case files which are already uploaded on the website of the Commission."

3. On reply of Point 5, appellant has stated in the appeal that:-

"PIO has provided vague and incomplete information because:

Ref to seminar titled 'Implementation of the RTI Act' organized by the CIC on May 19; It was informed that the Central Information Commission (CIC) is working to clear all appeals filed in 2015 by September 2017 and those filed in 2016 by the end of 2017.

Hence in view of the above Expected date by which the 155 cases will be completed is warranted and must be available somewhere with Dy Reg IC(BJ)."

On reply of Point 6, appellant stated in the appeal that:

"<u>Infirmity</u> Misleading information provided by PIO

PIO has not provided proof that the pending show-cause notice that are listed on Website under MIS Reports. Further, the Website has been revisited and it has been observed that the pending show-cause cases under MIS Reports section are not listed on the Website.

PIO also failed to provide the list and expected date by which the same will be uploaded."

Decision with reasons:-

- During the hearing, appellant has reiterated the same. On Point-5, Shri K.L. Das, CPIO & DO to IC(BJ) has submitted that there is no time frame for disposal of such cases, therefore, he cannot provide expected date by which these 155 cases will be completed. On Point-6, Shri Das has submitted that the Show-Cause Notices are contained in the orders of the respective case files which are already uploaded on the website of the Commission. The appellant may check the same in the CIC's website link http://dsscic.nic.in/cause-list-report-web/view-decision-all/1 by entering the desired case file number or name of the appellant etc as shown in the display menu.
- From the above, it is observed that information provided by the CPIO is factual and appropriate, therefore, no intervention is required on the part of the FAA, in the matter.
- 6. The appeal is, therefore, disposed off accordingly.

7. In case the appellant is aggrieved by the decision, he is free to file second appeal, if he so desires, before the Central Information Commission, Baba Gang Nath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 against this order within 90 days.
