Appellant was earlier advised to file first appeal through online portal of DoPT i.e. https://rtionline.gov.in/ or by post/hand, her.ceforth and if he still intends to file first appeal through email, he may ensured that appeal should invariably be signed otherwise that will not be entertained. But he again sent present unsigned appeal through email. Appellant is once again advised to file first appeal through proper mode, in future.

Brief facts of the case:-

- 2. In the RTI application, appellant has sought following information:-
 - "1. List of the Dept's, which didn't submitted the mandatory data', under Section 25(3).
 - 2. List of the Dept's, which submitted the mandatory 'da'a', under Section 25(3).
 - 3. Copies of the instructions, guidelines issued by Hon'ble Commission from time-to-time to the respective departments of the Central Government & to Union Territories to submit quarterly, annual, reports under Section 25(1), and to 'upload' 'data', on their 'website'.."
- 3. In the appeal, appellant has stated that:-
 - "....it is incumbent upon 'public authority' to provide information within 'thirty days' whereas, in the present case information was not provided though mandatory period to provide information was already over on 02.01.2019, which attracts Section 20(1) of the RTI-Act-2005."

Decision with reasons:-

- 4. On perusal of the record of concerned case file, it is found that Shri Jeewan Chandra, Consultant/CPIO(MR) has already supplied information vide letter dated 10.01.2019. A copy of the same is enclosed herewith.
- 5. Further, on perusal of the RTI application and CPIO's reply, it is observed that information furnished by the CPIO on Points 1 & 2 is appropriate. However, information provided on Point 3 is found incomplete and inappropriate, therefore, **Shri Jeewan** Chandra, CPIO/Consultant(IWR) is directed to re-visit the matter and provide appropriate complete information to the appellant within 1 week from the date of receipt of the order.
- 6. The appeal is, therefore, disposed of.
- 7. In case the appellant is aggrieved by the decision, he is free to file second appeal, if he so desires, before the Central Information Commission, Baba Gang Nath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 against this order within 90 days.
