Record of proceedings:

1. I have gone through the RTI application dated 29/06/2019 filed by Sh. Jasbir Singh Arora requesting for supplying the certified copies of all the documents which were filed by him in 2019 as per the details provided in the RTI application.
2. Sh. H.P. Sen, CPIO has sent a reply dated 15/07/2019 to Sh. Jasbir Singh Arora in response to the RTI application referred to above, mentioning therein that the information sought is not readily available and collection/compilation will cause disproportionate diversion of resources. He has also mentioned that Sh. Arora has been filing repeated RTI applications seeking myriad details pertaining to his Appeals/Complaints/Non-compliance petitions with the intention of venting out his apparent angst on the quasi judicial decisions passed by the Commission. It is further mentioned that Sh. Arora has caused immense mental agony to the CPIO despite the fact that all his RTI applications had been responded with utmost diligence while also affording every opportunity desired by him to inspect all the available records.
3. Sh. Sen, CPIO has also stated that Sh. Arora has resorted to several verbal spats with the CPIO telephonically and in person, to the extent of giving out threats and warnings, none of which is in line with the letter and spirit of RTI Act, 2005. Most of the RTI applications filed by Sh. Jasbir Singh Arora seek voluminous data which is not maintained or seek to interrogate the CPIO.



4. Sh. Jasbir Singh Arora filed a First Appeal dated 21/07/2019 against the aforementioned reply of the CPIO mentioning therein that the details have not been provided as sought by him and the grounds of Appeal has been mentioned as 'refused access to information requested'.

5. During the hearing of the First Appeal, Sh. Jasbir Singh Arora has requested to allow him to withdraw Appeal No. CICOM/A/2019/60110. His request has been allowed and the Appeal has been closed, accordingly.

Sh. Jasbir Singh Arora is further informed if he is not satisfied with the order of the undersigned, he is free to file a Second Appeal under Section 19 (1) of the RTI Act, 2005 before the Hon'ble Information Commissioner Sh. Divya Prakash Sinha at the above mentioned address within a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of this order.
