Brief facts:

- 1. The Appellant, Sh. R.R. Tripathy sought the following information vide his RTI application dated 21/08/2019 from the CPIO, office of IC (DP):
 - I. Number of cases in excess of 300 decided by Sh. D.P. Sinha, IC from the date of his joining until 05/08/2019.
- 2. Sh. H.P. Sen, the concerned CPIO replied to the RTI application of the Appellant vide his letter dated 26/08/2019 intimating that no such record is maintained in the Registry.
- 3. Sh. R.R. Tripathy, the Appellant being dissatisfied with the information provided by the CPIO filed a First Appeal on the grounds 'details not provided, provided incomplete, misleading or false information'. He has further stated that,
 - i. The CPIO has wrongly denied the information which is fit to be provided to the Applicant.
 - ii. The CPIO has adopted callous and casual approach while deciding the request of the Applicant.
 - iii. The CPIO has not applied his mind while deciding the RTI request.
 - iv. The information sought for is very much under the control of the CPIO which has been denied causing huge disrespect to the RTI Act.
 - v. The information may kindly be provided to the Applicant.
- 4. I have gone through the entire record of this case and I am fully in agreement with the reply sent by the CPIO that no such record, as desired by the Appellant, is maintained in the said Registry. Moreover, as per the RTI Act, 2005 the CPIO is under an obligation to provide such information which is available with him and he is under no legal obligation to prepare or generate any information as desired by the Appellant.

Decision:

Therefore, I am of the considered view that the CPIO has rightly disposed off the RTI application filed by the Appellant.



2. Hence, the Appeal filed by the Appellant is dismissed being devoid of merits.

Sh. R.R. Tripathy is further informed if he is not satisfied with the order of the undersigned, he is ree to file a Second Appeal under Section 19 (1) of the RTI Act, 2005 before the Hon'ble Information Commissioner Sh. Divya Prakash Sinha at the above mentioned address within a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of this order.
