Sir,

I had filed second appeal with copies of applications and first appeal vide CIC Dy. No.185089 dated 26.11.2014 since the requested information was not provided by the CPIO in the Directorate General of Foreign Trade, New Delhi. Vide my RTI application dated 10.03.2016, I had sought to know the status of my appeal in view of appellate orders dated 28.01.2016 passed by the FAA in the CIC. 2nd appeal dated 26.11. 2014filed before the CIC could not be disposed of as the concerned file got misplaced in the CIC. I therefore, requested that the matter may be investigated and responsibility fixed for such carelessness. I had also requested the CIC to take penal action for non-furnishing of information.

Now I have received two letters from the CIC - (i) intimating the date of hearing as 25.04.2016 for my 2nd appeal in File No. CIC/CC/A/2014/02577/KY signed by yourself and (ii) letter No. CICOM/R/2016/00352 dated 15.03.2016 intimating that my application dated 10.03.2016 has been forwarded to the concerned CPIO.

Since the 2nd appeal has now been taken up, the second letter is not of much relevance, so I am not inclined to pursue in so far as RTI request is concerned. However, I am to request that responsibility be fixed for such inordinate delay so that the RTI requests are given due importance by all concerned.
