Sub: Providing assistance u/s 5(2) of RTI Act, 2005.

Sir,

I am to refer to the communication No. CIC/CPIO/CR/2017/02 dated 27.01.2017 and CICOM/R/2017/00066 dated 25.01.2017 received from your good self and from Shri U.C. Joshi, Dy. Secretary & CPIO requesting to furnish reply to Point No.1, and 3 respectively. Accordingly the reply is given below:-

Point No.1

"It would be wrong to say that w.e.f 07.12.2016 'life and liberty' provision has been discontinued in CIC. As per section 7(i) of RTI Act, 2005, it is only in the RTI application cases filed u/s 6 of RTI Act wherein provision of life and liberty has been prevalent since enactment of RTI Act, 2005. That's why when second appeal invoking concern for life or liberty of a person was received in the Commission, the JS(Law), the then In-charge of Central Registry, put up the case on file on 07.12.2016 and the Chief Central Information Commissioner on 08.12.2016 concurred with the view of the JS(Law) that there is no merit to register the second appeal under life and liberty. To the best of the knowledge of the CPIO, it can be said to be an administrative order of Hon'ble Chief Central Information Commissioner.

Point No. 3

Though no liberty/concession of 'life/liberty' was accorded due to reasons enumerated in reply to Point No. 1 above on your complaint diarized vide DY No. 186899 dated 22.11.2016 a file no. CIC/CVCOM/C/2017 186899 has already been generated.
