**Sub: Providing of information under RTI Act. 2005.**

**Madam,**

I am to refer to your online RTI application dated 04.08.2017 which has been registered vide no. CICOM/R/2017/50453. It has been received through online RTI MIS in Central Registry on 04.08.2017. The point-wise reply on it is as follows:-

The mistake caused due to oversight is regretted. It probably happened due to your mentioning of three different RTIs in your second appeal diarized vide Dy. No. 602492.

There is as such no rule framed by CIC prohibiting of filing of single second appeal against single file number. However, as per the practice, filing of multiple second appeals on same RTI application (s) is not permissible.

Further, there is as such no notification issued by CIC providing time frame for filing for second appeal after judgment of first appeal. However, RTI Act, 2005 & RTI Rules 2012 which are in public domain, the time limit has been specifically defined.

Your second appeal as per the existing rules practice is not admissible as as already mentioned above, filing of multiple second appeals on same RTI is not permissible as such cannot be admitted.

Moreover once a decision is pronounced the Commission, it cannot be reviewed or heard again.
