**Sub: Providing information under RTI Act. 2005.**

Sir,

I am to refer to your online RTI application dated 12.02.2018 which has been registered vide no. CICOM/R/2018/50113. It was received through online RTI MIS in Central Registry on 12.02.2018.

**Point-wise reply to your RTI application is as under:-**

- 1 to 4** Dehors section 2(f) of RTI Act, 2005 as advice/explanation/reasoning is being sought.
- 5** The scrutiny is done by the staff of outsourced agency, which may change it any time; as such providing name etc of it is not feasible; under the supervision of undersigned CPIO and DR.
- 6** Print out running into 3 pages, as generated form the Computerized Dak Management System of the Commission is enclosed herewith. **You are requested to provide a IPO/DD/Bankers cheque for Rs. 6/-** (@Rs. 2/- per page) in the name: "PAO, CAT, New Delhi" as a fee towards providing of desired documents, which, for sake of saving time, is being demanded prospectively.

**Appeal, if any, against this reply will lie to Shri Rakesh Kumar Singh, First Appellate Authority & Additional Secretary, CIC, Room No 502, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, Baba Gang Nath Marg, Munirka, Near Old JNU Campus, New Delhi-110067 within 30 days of receipt of reply of CPIO. Though, it would be out of place to mention here, it seems, your are aggrieved due to issue of Facilitation Memo (s) on the Second Appeal (s) filed by you. Your attention in this regard is drawn to section 19 (1) of RTI Act, 2005 (available in public domain) wherein it is specifically mentioned that, I quote "**19. Appeal.** – (1) Any person who, does not receive a decision within the time specified in sub-section (1) or clause (a) of sub-section (3) of section 7, or is aggrieved by a decision of the Central Public Information Officer or the State public Information Officer, as the case may be, may within thirty days from the expiry of such period or from the receipt of such a decision prefer an appeal to such officer **who is senior in rank to the Central Public Information Officer of the State Public Information Officer, as the case may be, in each public authority...**"

As such you are **advised to first avail efficacious legal remedy provided under RTI Act, 2005 by filing before appropriate first appellate authority, the first appeal** in the public authority against deemed refusal by CPIO concerned and then, if you are still not satisfied by first appellate authority's order or due to its deemed refusal, you may file a second appeal in this commission either using online portal (wherein care must be taken to attach appropriate document against the designated links ie a copy of RTI application against the link 'copy of RTI application'; against the link 'copy of first appeal' a copy of first appeal and against the link '**copy of second appeal**', **a second appeal as per the format prescribed in the Appendix to Rule 8 of RTI Rules 2012**, which infact not done by you while filing/refilling second appeal (s); rather in first case ie in diary no. 600170, so called second was found attached against "attachment 1" and in rest of the cases it was not in proper format) or offline by hand/post **so that it may be registered under the provision of RTI Act, 2005.**
